For those of you planning to go to Grapevine, TX in September for the Thunderbird Convention, there are a couple of "must" stops while enroute:

#1. The 1st Missouri Visitors Center, after leaving lowa, on I-35 (near Eagleville, MO.). They have an unbelievable mosaic mural & metal sculpture walkway. This is the finest visitors center that we have encountered anywhere in the U.S.

#2. Chickasha, OK. If you are familiar with the movie "A Christmas Story" you have to visit the iconic giant "Leg Lamp" (lit up at night). People from all over the world are going to Chickasha to see it. It's not far off your drive to Grapevine (40 miles soutyh of Oklahoma City on I-44) & from Chickasha, you can take Hwy 81 to near Grapevine.

Chickasha: The town of Chickasha paid homage to the classic film "A Christmas Story" when it placed a 50-foot tall replica of the iconic leg lamp and box labeled "fragile" in 2022, driving a tourism boost and generating millions in downtown investments. According to documents, Warner Bros, sent a letter to the Chickasha Community Foundation in 2024 demanding the \$1.4 million sculpture be "removed and destroyed," claiming the foundation had committed copyright infringement. But the foundation's attorneys responded to that letter, arguing against the infringement claims, Warner Bros, has not been in contact since, said Jim Cowan, president of the Chickasha Chamber of Commerce and representative for the Chickasha Community Foundation.

If you are planning on breakfast or coffee at McDonalds, arrive earlier before the scheduled leave time.




Dam Days—Jaturday Way John




